CHARTER

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 2nd day of December, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **ROBERT HALL CLOTHES OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **Greenville, South Carolina**
(Mailing Address: **409 E. North Street, Greenville, South Carolina**)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To conduct the business of retailers and wholesalers of men's, ladies' and children's wearing apparel; to buy, sell, deal in and trade in at wholesale, retail and otherwise, import and export, goods, wares, merchandise and property of every kind and description, and all types of men's, ladies' and children's wearing apparel, sportswear, and all other kinds and types of wearing apparel consisting of all types and kinds of fabrics and materials that may enter into the manufacture of men's, ladies' and children's articles of apparel.

To own, lease, operate and maintain wholesale and retail stores and other selling outlets, and buying and selling offices necessary for the purchase and sale, at wholesale or retail or otherwise, of men's, ladies' and children's wearing apparel of every kind and description and goods, wares, merchandise and property of every kind and description.

To own, lease, operate, maintain, use, manage, install and equip factories, plants and mills for the manufacture and sale of men's, ladies' and children's wearing apparel of every kind and description and goods, wares, merchandise and property of every kind and description.

To engage in radio advertising, and to purchase, lease, use, operate, sell and dispose of all necessary facilities, equipment, rights and privileges incident thereto; to conduct newspaper, magazine, and other advertising campaigns; to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts for advertising and bringing to public attention goods, wares and merchandise of every class and description.

To have one or more offices, to carry on all or any of its operations and business and without restriction or limit as to amount to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in South Carolina and any of the States, Districts, Territories or Colonies of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, subject to the laws of such State, District, Territory, Colony or Country.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of South Carolina upon corporations formed under the act hereinafter referred to, and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.

The objects and purposes specified in the foregoing clauses shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in nowise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this Declaration for Charter, but the objects and purposes specified in each of the foregoing clauses of this article shall be regarded as independent objects and purposes.
