

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of Bennett's Bridge Road, at joint front corner of Tracts 3 and 4, thence along the center of said road, S. 87-58 W. 164.2 feet to a nail; thence still with the center of said road, N. 78-55 W. 664.6 feet to a nail in the center of road at center of branch; thence down the center of the branch, the traverse line being N. 27 W. 205 feet to a point in center of branch; thence still with the center of the branch, the traverse line being N. 35-15 W. 185 feet to a point in the center of another branch on the Northwest side of Rocky Creek; thence up the center of said branch, the traverse line being N. 60-18 W. 450 feet to a stake at corner of property now or formerly of J. W. Bagwell; thence along said Bagwell line, N. 16-09 W., 1382.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of now or formerly Bomar, N. 77-51 E. 832 feet to an iron pin at the corner of now or formerly Harold B. McKinney; thence with the line of said McKinney property, S. 74-03 E. 421.2 feet passing an iron pin to the center of Rocky Creek; thence with Rocky Creek, the traverse line of which is approximately S. 7-01 W., 634.3 feet to a nail in wooden bridge over said creek at the corner of Tract 3 in the center of an old roadbed of a county road (now abandoned); thence up the center of Rocky Creek alongthe line of Tract 3, the traverse line being S. 8-16 W. 500.3 feet to an iron pin in the center of a branch; thence still with the line of Tract 3 and with the center of said branch, the traverse line being S. 46-54 E. 474.4 feet to a point in center of said branch; thence still with the center of said branch and with the line of Tract 3, the traverse line being S. 83-06 E. 259.8 feet to an iron pin in center of said branch; thence still with the line of Tract 3, S. 13-14 E. 569 feet to center of Bennett's Bridge road, the beginning corner, and containing 44.3 acres, more or less. -205- 539.2-1-4
