Bagwell does now and hereby grants, bargains, sells and releases unto said M. B. Bagwell, that certain lot in its Cemetery in Butler township, Rocky Creek Baptist Church, seven miles East of Greenville, S. C., and known as the Rocky Creek New Cemetery of the said Church, being designated and marked by cement markers and known as lot No. 11 in Section 3 and containing 200 square feet.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said lot to said M. B. Bagwell and his heirs and assigns forever, to be used for the interment of dead white persons only, and to be held, used, conveyed, devised or descend subject to the By-laws, Rules and Regulations for the Cemetery of said church, at present of force or as hereafter amended or adopted and as may be shown by the minutes or other records of said Church.

Witness the seal of Rocky Creek Baptist Church and the hand of Marvin M. Jones its Chairman of Board of Deacons, and countersigned by Robert F. Montgomery the Secretary of the Church as provided by its minutes this 11 day of July A. D. 1932.
