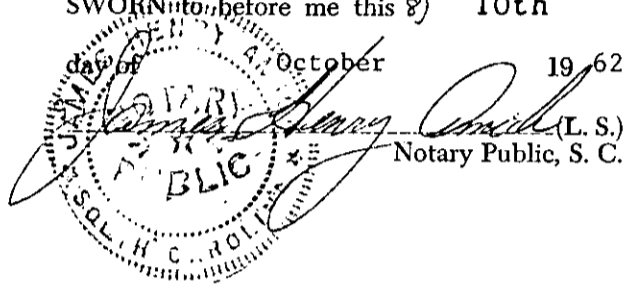

RENUNCIATION OF DOWER

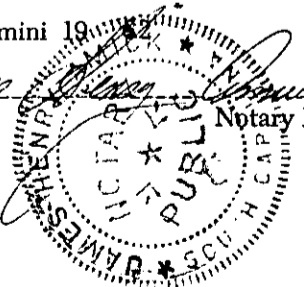
