Wilma Waldrop Barton, Annie Mae Wingo Morgan, Elmer Brewton Waters, and Inez Moss Satterfield, as Trustees of the Dogwood Acres Community Club, their Successors and Assigns in office forever; subject to reversionary rights hereinafter set forth and defined:
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal. Township, Greenville

County. State of South Carolina, located about one mile northward from the Corporate limits of the City of Greer, lying on the northeast side of Memorial Drive Extension, or State Highway No. 110, being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 10 and 11 on a plat of property made for W. Dennis Smith, by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 29, 1952, recorded in Plat Book T, page 452, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, reference to said plat and record thereof being expressly made for a complete and detailed description of said lots.

The above lots are the same as conveyed to the grantors by deeds which are on record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Books 573 and 652, at pages 517 and 396, respectively.

This deed is executed to the Trustees of the Dogwood Acres Community Club for the use and benefit of the members of said club in the promotion of worthwhile projects in the community where the members of the group reside, the primary object of the group being to create a better community, better understanding and relations among the residents of the community, to create an interest in the beautification of homes and gardens and other worthwhile projects.
