HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said R.C. Avery, all the right, title and interest of the minor defendant, Michael Roger McBee, in and to the following described real estate:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, near the Southern Bleachery and Print Works colored section known as BLACK TOP, being bounded on the north, east and south by other lands of myself, and on the west by a lacre lot of Williams Hawkins, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by Charles Hammett, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of W. A. Hammett, deceased, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
