All the right, title and interest of the minor defendants, Eugenia Thomason and Ralph Archie Thomason, in and to the following described real estate:	
"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near th Town of Fountain Inn, on the Old Georgia Road, known as the L. P. Armstrong Home Place, and being in two tracts and having the following courses and distances as is shown by a Plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, made under date January 2, 1939, to-wit:	
BEGINNING at a stake in road designated as road to Fountain Inn, known as the Georgia Road; running thence S. 24 E. 2056 feet to a stake along line of J. W.
