ALL that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Highland Township, containing 21.12 acres, more or less, and shown on a plat entitled property of Clarence Barton Estate made by J. C. Hill, March 25, 1964, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a railroad spike in the center of a County road at the corner of property of Frances Barton and running thence with her property, S. 15 W., 1,924 feet to a red oak stump; thence S. 22 W.. 128 feet to a stone at the center of the Old Greenville Road; thence with the center of the Old Greenville Road, as shown on said plat. 2,102 feet to a railroad spike in the center of the aforementioned County road; thence with the center of said County road, S. 46 - 30 E., 336 feet, S. 78 E., 71 feet and S. 86 - 10 E., 341 feet to the point of beginning.
