TOGETHER with the right of ingress and egress;

ALSO the further right to place and maintain for the term of this lease upon and within (1) the Kemper Street station building of Railroad at Lynchburg, Virginia, (2) the office building of Railroad at 99 Spring Street, Atlanta, Fulton County, Georgia, (3) the office building of Railroad at 713 West Trade Street, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, (4) the yard office building of Railroad at John Sevier Yard, Knox County, Tennessee, and (5) the yard office building of Railroad at Inman Yard, Fulton County, Georgia, all equipment of the type mentioned in Article 2 hereof necessary for the maintenance and operation of a microwave communication system, including in the case of (4) the right to place a tower on Railroad property adjacent to said office building.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said leased premises unto Realty for a term of TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS beginning as of the 1st day of December, 1964, upon Realty's

YIELDING AND PAYING, however, unto Railroad during the term of this lease, as rental for the properties hereinbefore described, the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1) per annum, payable in advance, beginning on the first day of December, 1964.

2. Said premises hereby leased shall be used by Realty for the purpose of and in connection with the maintenance and use of the existing multi-channel microwave and very high frequency radio communications system, said system to be leased to and operated by Railroad in the conduct of its business. Realty shall have the right to maintain and use upon said leased premises the existing towers, buildings, structures, facilities and equipment now located thereupon, and to construct or place upon said leased premises, and upon adjoining premises of Railroad at locations to be approved by the Superintendent of Railroad, such additional structures, facilities and equipment as may be necessary and desirable in connection with such microwave and radio system.

3. Such towers, buildings, structures, microwave communication facilities and equipment in the existing microwave and radio system and any additional towers, buildings, structures, microwave communication facilities and equipment as Realty may, at the expense of Realty, elect to construct on the aforementioned property of Railroad shall at all times remain the personal
