8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

To engage in the business of constructing, renovating, repairing and/or otherwise improving any kind of building for itself or on contract for others; to buy, sell, develop, improve, subdivide and/or lease real estate; and to do any and all things necessary or incidental to the operation of the business.

9. Provisions which the incorporators elect to include in the articles of incorporation are as follows:
