KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that BURLINGTON INDUSTRIES, INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware with executive offices in Greensboro, North Carolina, by donation to the CITY OF GREENVILLE, a political subdivision of the State of South Carolina, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the City of Greenville, South Carolina:

All that water line, main, valves, and appurtenances located and installed in Bridge Road at Taylors, Greenville County, South Carolina, being 813 feet of 8-inch cast iron pipe and one 2-inch valve, all as shown on drawing dated April 8, 1966, entitled "Burlington Industries, Inc. to City of Greenville" attached hereto and made a part of this conveyance.

Together with the right to keep and maintain in the aforementioned street or roadway said water line now located therein (together with all apparatus and equipment used in connection therewith) and together with from time to time the right to repair and replace the same and to install, maintain, repair and replace other water lines in addition thereto or any substitutions thereof including any and all apparatus and equipment used in connection therewith as the same may be necessary, with the further right to enter upon said street or roadway at any time for the purpose of installing such other water lines and maintaining, repairing, inspecting and operating same
