

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the western side of Elaine Avenue in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. Sixteen (16) on a plat of the property of William M. Edwards made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January 29, 1952, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "S", at Page 12, reference to which is craved for a more complete description thereof.
