Whereas, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, the City of Greenville is authorized to levy taxes and assess property within the limits of said city for taxation, and upon default in the payment thereof to issue under the hand and seal of the Clerk of the City Council of the City of Greenville an execution directed to some officer designated for the collection of delinquent taxes, requiring and commanding him to levy the same by distress and sale of so much of the defaulting taxpayers' estate, real, personal, or both, as may be sufficient to satisfy the taxes and charges thereon so levied and assessed; and further that said officer may take possession of such property and after due advertisement, sell and dispose of the same as in such cases provided by law, make titles thereto and put the purchaser in possession, 1964 and 1965

And, whereas, there appears on the Tax Books of said City for the fiscal year 1963/certain real estate consisting of

Whereas, the above named J. C. and Loede Morris
having neglected to pay the City of Greenville the above taxes, assessments and penalties as provided by law, an execution was issued therefor, on the 20th day of April 1966
and lodged with the Delinquent Tax Collector of said City.

And, whereas, in accordance with law, said Delinquent Tax Collector did seize, levy upon, advertise for sale, and did on the 6th day of June 1966 sell the same at public auction to the highest bidder, for cash, and one Eddie Nasser became the purchaser and complied with the terms of sale.

Now, therefore, I, L. E. Spann, Delinquent Tax Collector for the City of Greenville, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the sum of \$100.00
One hundred and no/100 Dollars,
have granted, bargained, sold and released and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eddie Nasser his heirs and assigns,

Beginning at a stake corner of land formerly owned by N. R. Wilson on King Street and running thence N. 31 W 101 Ft. to a stake; thence S. 55.3 W 51 Ft. to a stake on Pine Street (formerly Frank Street) thence S 4-30 E 113 ft. 9 inches to a stake on corner of said Pine Street and King St., thence N. 55-30 E 103 ft. to the beginning corner on King St.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Eddie Nasser heirs and assigns forever.
