This matter comes before me by petition of the attorneys representing the respective parties.

It appears that respondents instituted this statutory condemnation proceeding to acquire certain additional right of way from the appellant's property, located at the intersection of Pendleton and Willis Streets in the City of Greenville, for purposes of constructing the new crosstown Academy Street or Route 123 project. The project plans (see S.C.H.D. File 23.540, Project U-2627(2), part 2, sheets 25 and 26) reveal that Academy Street, a new highway, will intersect with Pendleton Street just beyond the point where Willis Street formerly entered Pendleton Street. Concrete curb and sidewalk will be installed to separate Willis and Pendleton Streets, the objective being to close or block any vehicular entry between Willis and Pendleton Streets. Provision is made for an entrance into new Academy Street from Willis Street. In effect, Willis Street will have no entrance into or from Pendleton Street, although said Willis Street will have an entrance into new Academy Street.
