HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Winfred W. Anderson and Lucia Anderson, all the right, title and
interest of the defendant, Thelma Gordon, in and to the following
described real estate:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and being near
the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in a Section known
as Nickletown, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:
Beginning on the Main Street at the corner of J. W. Goddard line,
and running thence along said line in a westerly direction 160- $\frac{1}{2}$ feet;
thence in a southerly direction 139 and $\frac{1}{6}$ feet to a street;
thence along said street in an Easterly direction 157 and $\frac{1}{6}$ feet
to the corner of the Main Street; thence along the line of the Main
Street in a Northerly direction 93 and $\frac{1}{5}$ feet to the beginning
point, and being known as a portion of the H. W. Hunt Subdivision,
