REAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

Hereby assign, transfer and set over to Bank, its successors and assigns, all monies now due and hereafter becoming due to undersigned, as rental, or otherwise, and howsoever for or on account of that certain real property situated in the County of , State of South Carolina, described as follows: Guenville

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.
- 5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.
- 6.
