to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Ronald C. Howell and his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO:

All that certain parcel or lot of land containing 7 acres, more or less, situated on the east side of the Groce Meadow Road, about 6 miles northward from the City of Greer, Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lot No. 2 on a plat of the property of R. P. Howell by W. N. Willis, Engineers, dated October 10, 1967, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of the Groce Meadow Road, corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence along said road, N. 32-51 W. 48 feet, N. 28 W. 295 feet and N. 24-00 W. 618 feet to a nail in the road; thence N. 57-12 E. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-30 E. 987 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 1; thence along the line of Lot No. 1, N. 62-30 E. 396 feet to the beginning corner.
