MacDONALD**:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the South-eastern side of Primrose Lane in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on a plat prepared by Campbell & Clarkson, dated March 25, 1964, revised July 26, 1968, entitled "Final Plat Northside Gardens Pool, Inc.", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book UUU at page 43, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Primrose Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 3 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 3 S. 39-35 E. 185.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-45 E. 183 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 41-19 W. 247.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Primrose Lane; thence with the Southeastern side of Primrose Lane S. 75-41 W. 41.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of Primrose Lane S. 61-41 W. 110 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of James M. Gilfillin, dated August 10, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 531 at page 487.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, zoning ordinances, set back lines, roadways, easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property.
