ALL that parcel or tract of land situate at the Northeast corner of the intersection of West Washington Street and North Academy Street in the City of Greenville in Greenville County, S. C., and having according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the intersection of West Washington Street and North Academy Street and runs thence along the East side of North Academy Street, N. 14-49 E. 26.55 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the East side of North Academy Street, N. 22-56 E. 55.97 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-02 E. 71.75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-28 W. 82.5 feet to an iron pin on the North side of West Washington Street; thence along the North side of West Washington Street, N. 69-02 W. 65.8 feet to the beginning corner.

Townes, Aurelia Townes Schawlow and Charles Hard Townes conveyed their interest in this property to the grantor, George F.
