L. H. Lyle, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near Paris Station, and being shown and designated as Lot No. 15 according to a plat called "Map of Piedmont Estates, Paris Station, made December, 1944 by Dalton & Neves, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C.
