- 16. <u>REVISIONS</u>. These covenants, conditions and restrictions may be revised, revoked, substituted, amended, modified or otherwise altered by the owners of a majority of the area in square feet within Pelham Executive Plaza, and this paragraph shall include any area which has been added to Pelham Executive Plaza by or with the consent of the Developer.
- 17. PARTIAL INVALIDITY. The invalidation of any one of these restrictions or the failure to enforce any of said restrictions in the event of its violation shall in no event affect any of the other restrictions nor be deemed a waiver of the right to enforce the same thereafter.
- 18. TERM. Each condition, covenant, and restriction is to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them for a period of 20 years from the date these conditions, covenants, and restrictions are recorded. However, these conditions, covenants and restrictions shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years each unless an instrument is signed by a majority of the then owners of all of the lots in said office park as shown in the aforementioned plat, or as enlarged by the addition of other land to the office park, agreeing to change said covenant in whole or in part, subject to the written consent of the Developer.
