All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 104, Nichol-town Heights, plat of which is recorded in RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F page 68 and being more particularly described according to revised plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M page 4, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
