

6. The wife shall make all house payments on the house during the period she occupies this house. The husband shall pay the insurance and the taxes on the house.

7. The husband further agrees that at the time of his death the house shall become the property of the children of the parties living at the time of his death.

8. The husband agrees to convey to the wife the furnishings in the house and to provide her with the use of the 1969 Chevrolet automobile presently in her possession, or its equivalent and the husband agrees to maintain the liability insurance on said automobile.

9. The husband further agrees to pay the wife's attorney's fee for the divorce action in the total sum of Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$325.00).

10. In consideration for the foregoing, the wife agrees to relieve the husband of all further obligations not hereinabove set forth.
