LEASE AGREEMENT AND OPTION TO PURCHASE

1. THIS AGREEMENT OF LEASE made and entered into this lst day of June, 1972, by and between DOROTHY F. HARRON, hereinafter called "Landlord", and JURAL ASSOCIATES, INC. hereinafter called "Tenant".

## WITNESSETH:

2. That in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained, the Landlord hereby demises and leases unto Tenant, its successors and assigns, the following described property:
