Hollingsworth in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Hollingsworth, his heirs and assigns forever, all those pieces, parcels or lots of land described as follows:

TRACT NO. 1 All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 32 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a railroad spike in the center line of the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad, and running thence N. 24-17 E. 621.2 feet to a stone; thence N. 79-54 E. 1235.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44-55 E. 239.4 feet to a point on the right-of-way of the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad spur to the Nylon Industries plant; thence along the right-of-way of said spur S. 17-08 E. 325 feet to a point; thence still with said right-of-way, S. 71-43 W.
