All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the southwestern corner of the intersection of Pennwood Lane with Wakewood Way near Paris Mountain, being shown as Lot No. 9 on a plat of IMPERIAL HILL, made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, dated August, 1964, and recorded in Plat Book BBB, Page 35, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to-wit:
