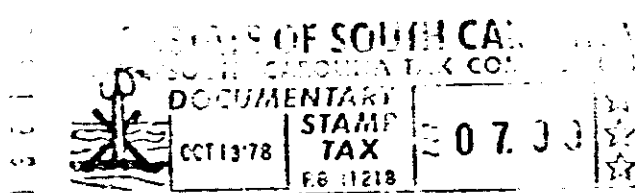

"ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Bates Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Northerly side of a County road and being more particularly described according to a survey and plat of property of Miguel Medina and Hazel R. Medina made by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, dated October 4, 1978, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
