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**Real Property Agreement**

In consideration of such loans and indebtedness ~~made~~ <sup>made</sup> by or become due to Bankers Trust of South Carolina, N.A. (hereinafter referred to as Bank) to or from the undersigned jointly or severally and of such loans and indebtedness have been paid in full or until twenty-one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned jointly and severally promise and agree:

- 1 To pay prior to becoming delinquent all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below, and
- 2 Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of the real property described below or any interest therein or any leases, rents or funds held under escrow agreement relating to said premises, and
- 3 The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being more particularly described as Lot #33 of Reedy Acres Sub-Division. Being a portion of the land conveyed to W. E. Perry from Hattie D. Perry and C. O. Perry, Jr. in deed dated May 24, 1947, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 113 at Page 108. Plat recorded in R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book AAA, Page 31, under date of May 24, 1947.

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That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof or if default be made in any payment of principal or interest on any notes hereof or hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the bank and agrees that any judge or jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the described premises, with full authority to take possession thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court, but agrees further that the bank shall have no obligation to perform or discharge any obligation, duty or liability of the undersigned in connection with the said assignment of rents and profits.

4 That if default be made in the payment of loans and indebtedness hereunder or the performance of any of the terms hereof, Bank at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

5 That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank in its discretion may elect.

6 Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
