RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the undersigned, owner(s) of the premises described below, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its licensees, agents, successors, assigns, and allied and associated companies, a right of way easement to construct, operate, maintain, add or remove such lines or systems of communications or related services as the grantee may require, consisting of:

(1) poles, guys, anchors, aerial cables and wires;

(2) buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, splicing boxes and pedestals;

(3) masts, supports, markers, underground cables and wires;

(4) and other amplifiers, boxes, appurtenances or devices

upon over and under a strip of land 5 feet wide across the following lands: GREENVILLE, State of SOUTH CAROLINA, generally described as follows:

AS THAT PARCEL OF LAND ON THE EAST BOUNDED BY THE PROPERTIES OF EDITH B. MCLEAN AND H.R. STEPHENSON, ON THE NORTH BY PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, AND ON THE SOUTH AND WEST BY THE PROPERTIES OF HUBBIS INC., C. PAUL MANLY, AND ROBERT T. ASHADRE. THIS PARCEL OF LAND IS FURTHER DESCRIBED AS BEING FOUND IN THE GREENVILLE COUNTY TAX BOOKS AS MAP 443, BLOCK 1, AND LOT 22 AND 22.1.

and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, over, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.

The following rights are also granted: to allow any other person or company to attach wires or lay cables or conduit within the right of way, for communications or electric power transmission or distribution; ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth or other obstructions within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution.

The receipt of FIVE HUNDRED NO 00 Dollars (\$500.00) is hereby acknowledged by the undersigned.

To have and to hold the above granted easement unto Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns forever.
