All that certain piece, parcel, tract of land or lot of land situate and lying in the Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the west side of Buncombe Surface Treated Road leading from Greer S. C. toward Hendersonville, North Carolina, about five (5) miles from Greer, S. C. and having the following metes and bounds to wit:- BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of J. B. Brookshire land against Buncombe Road go S. 23 W. 208 feet and 6 inches to iron pin on line of J. B. Brookshire; thence S. 59 E. 208 ft. 6 inches to iron pin; thence N. 23 E. 208 ft. 6 inches to iron pin on edge of Buncombe Road; thence N. 59 W. with said Road 208 ft. 6 inches to beginning corner, containing one (1) acre more or less according to survey made by M. O. Owens, Surveyor, April 16, 1935, and reference is craved to plat of said survey for more detailed information.

Also that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Oneal Township, lying on the South side of Buncombe Road (Now State Highway No. 415), being a "L" in shape, bounded on the north by lot of William T. Bishop and the said highway 415, on the east and south by other lands of Sue P. Bishop and on the west by the lot of William T. Bishop and lands formerly of the Brookshire Estate, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:- Beginning on an iron pin on the south edge of the said highway, the northeast corner of the William T. Bishop lot, and runs thence with the east line of this lot, S. 23-15 W. 208.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the south line of the said lot, N. 58-45 W. 208.5 feet to a stake on the former Brooksire land; thence with the line of this, the Brookshire line, S. 23-15 W. 104.5 feet to an iron pin on the said line; thence a new line S. 58-45 E. 269.5 feet to an iron pin; thence another new line N. 31-15 E. 310 feet to an iron pin on the south margin of the said highway; thence with the south margin of the said highway, N. 58-45 W. 104.5 feet to the beginning corner, containing one and eight one-hundredths (1.08) acres, more or less.
