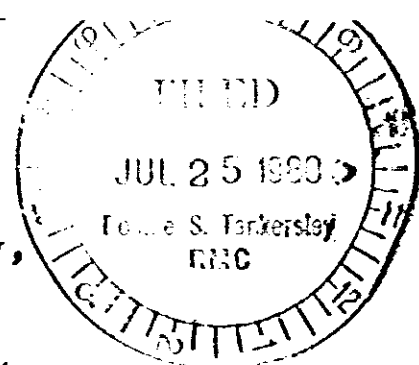

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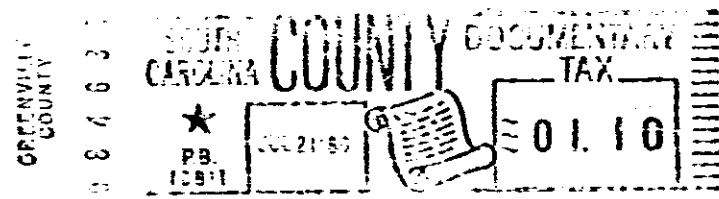
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I James L. Pulley,

in consideration of (\$ 1,000.00) One Thousand and No/100 Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Shirley A. Roach, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, State Of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 75 on a plat of property of H. B. Bates, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in Plat "F" at Page 32, said lot having a frontage of 75 feet on the East side of Bishop Street, with a depth in parallel lines of 129.3 feet on the East side and 131.5 feet on the West side, and being identically the same lot conveyed to Nellie B. Pulley by L. O. Blanchette by deed dated June 18, 1947, recorded in R. M. C. OFFICE FOR GREENVILLE COUNTY in Deed Book 313 at Page 423; said Nellie B. Pulley having departed this life intestate on May 12, 1957, leaving as sole heirs at law and distriburees, her husband, J. L. Pulley and her son, Anthony Mike Pulley, who also died intestate with transfer of property to grantors stated in Apt.1236 File 8.

This being the same property James L. Pulley bought from Carl G. Moize and May B. Moize by deed of November 13th 1973 and recorded in R. M. C. Office For Greenville County in Book 988 Of Deeds at Page 150.
