

The above tract is a portion of that property conveyed to J. Rowley Henderson by deed of W. P. Chiles and H. W. Chiles, dated November 19, 1909, and recorded that same date in Greenville County Deed Book 5 at Thereafter, J. Rowley Henderson died testate at Greenville County, South Carolina, on November 14, 1952, reference being made to Greenville County Probate file Apartment 615 at Page 38, leaving a life estate in his wife, Kitty Arnold Henderson, with a remainder interest to his children, Roy L. Henderson, James R. Henderson, Harry L. Henderson, W. Lua Henderson and Kathryn H. Griffin. Thereafter, said Kitty Arnold Henderson died intestate at Greenville County, South Carolina, in January, 1961, leaving her children above named as her sole heirs at law. Roy L. Henderson thereafter died testate at Greenville County, South Carolina, on November 26, 1971, reference being made to Greenville County Probate file Apartment 1207 at File 21, leaving as his sole heir at law his wife, Jennie S. Henderson.
