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- 2. Agnew shall use the easement granted herein with due regard to the rights of others and their use of the subject property and shall not use the driveway in any way that will impair the rights of others to use it, and shall not obstruct passage thereon.
- The land affected by the grant of this easement is shown on a plat entitled "Survey for Joe G. Thomason" made by Carolina Surveying Company dated December 3, 1981, recorded in Plat Book 8X at Page 93 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an X in concrete on the eastern side of Wilton Street at the joint front corner of property belonging to Thomason and property belonging to Agnew, said beginning point being located S. 1-41 W. 66.67 feet, more or less, from the intersection of West Croft Street with Wilton Street and running thence along the common boundary line of the Thomason property and the Agnew property, S. 83-13 E. 47 feet to an X in concrete; thence S. 1-44 W. 2 feet to an X in concrete; thence N. 85-39 W. 46.9 feet to an X in concrete on the eastern side of Wilton Street; thence along the eastern side of Wilton Street, N. 1-41 E. 4 feet to an X in concrete, the point of beginning.

4. This agreement shall be binding upon the respective parties hereto, their heirs, executors and administrators and assigns, forever.
