In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the undersigned, owner(s) of the premises described below, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its licensees, agents, successors, assigns, and allies and associated companies, a right of way easement to construct, operate, maintain, and/or remove such lines or systems of communications or related services as the grantee may require, consisting of:

- (1) poles, guys, anchors, aerial cables and wires;
- (2) buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, splicing boxes and pedestals;
- (3) conduits, manholes, markers, underground cables and wires;
- (4) and other apparatus, boxes, countermances or devices.

upon over and under a strip of land 6 feet wide across the following lands in Greenville, County, State of South Carolina generally described as follows:

A six (6) feet square consisting of the north six (6) feet of the west fifty (50) feet and the west six (6) feet of the north 129.4 feet of Lot 29 Block 1 as recorded on Greenville Tax Map 265 and more accurately described by the sketch on back.

and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, over, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.

The following rights are also granted: to allow any other person or company to attach wires or lay cable or conduit within the right of way for communications or electric power transmission or distribution; ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, underneath or other obstructions within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution.
