J. Wood, as Executor of the Estate of H. S. Wood, and Florie Griffith and Madeline Wood Vaughn, which Deed is recorded in Book of Deeds, Volume 277, page 288, in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. Werron Jason Wood died testate on December 3, 1975, leaving a valid Last Will and Testament dated June 13, 1956, disposing of his entire estate, which was duly admitted to probate in the Probate Court of Greenville County, South Carolina, on December 10, 1975, as appears more fully in the records of the Greenville County Probate Court at Apartment 1405.
