All of that lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Kondros Circle, containing 2.14 acres and being more fully described as follows according to plat entitled Survey for James Jr. and Eleanor Neeley, prepared by Enwright Associates, Inc. on July 21, 1982, which plat is recorded in the R.
