To do any other thing or perform any other act, not limited to the foregoing, which I might do in person, it being intended that this shall be a general power of attorney.

This power of attorney shall remain effective until the same is revoked by written instrument recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Elbert County, Georgia.
