This matter comes before me upon the verified Complaint of Edward R. Hamer, Jr., as Trustee for the Cuy B. Foster Trust Fund. It appears from the record that this matter was duly commenced by the service of a Summons and Complaint against the Defendants on April 29, 1983. It further appears from the record herein that no responsive pleadings have been filed and that the Defendants are in default. This matter was heard before me on June 1, 1983, pursuant to an Order of Reference wherein I was directed to make a final judgment in this matter.

At the hearing, Edward R. Hamer, Jr., was present and testified. He was represented by his attorney, James H. Cassidy. It appears from the record that on January 16, 1970, the Defendants herein entered into a promissory note wherein they agreed to pay the sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred and NO/100 Dollars (\$8,500.00) together with interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum in monthly installments of One Hundred and NO/100 Dollars (\$100.00) per month beginning January 16, 1970, for a period of six (6) months and thereafter Sixty-Five and NO/100 Dollars (\$65.00) per month until paid in full. The undisputed testimony of the Plaintiff herein is that the Defendants have been in continuous arrearage on this note and obligation. Mr. Hamer testified that he has contacted them personally on numerous occasions in lan effort to cure their arrearage, but they have failed to do so. In addition thereto, the Court was presented with correspondence forwarded to the Bullocks by counsel for the Plaintiff, James H. Cassidy. Said correspondence was dated August 30, 1982, and December 1, 1982, copies of which are made part of this record.
