This matter comes before the Court upon the verified Petition of William H. McCauley, II, Iverson O. Brownell, Jr., and Douglas M. Wilson, requesting that a certain street known as the northeasternmost portion of Wilmont Lane between Arcadia Circle and property owned by N. Barton Tuck in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, be closed and fee simple title thereto vested in the Petitioners. A hearing was held before the Court on December 22, 1983. *13(500) Pt. To = 211-6-25 OUT OF STREET*

I find that the Petitioners have complied with the requirements in §57-9-10 through §57-9-40 of the Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, 1976; that the required notice has been published once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Greenville Piedmont newspaper; that the westernmost portion of the proposed street to be closed runs into Arcadia Circle and Wilmont Lane the Petitioners herein own the property located on the northern and southern side of the street to be closed and N. Barton Tuck owns property abutting on the eastern portion of the street to be closed; that there are no other persons or parties owning or having any interest in the street to be closed; and that proper notice of the relief requested has been given to the City of Greenville and N. Barton Tuck.
