written minutes of all General Council meetings.

Ms. Tolden testified that she was present at the

August, 1978 and August, 1982 General Council meetings

and personally wrote minutes for those meetings.

The minutes of both those meetings, which she read to

the Court, disclosed that Leroy Williams was duly

elected Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The tenure

of office for this position is for four years.

No mention was made in said minutes of Naomi Strong,

either in a general sense or as being elected Chairman

of the Board of Trustees, as she alleges herein.

Mary Kinard testified as a member of the church and as teacher of the school which the church operated on the subject property for benefit of the children of church members. Ms. Kinard testified that she was selected teacher by the General Board of Trustees in 1976. She stated that she ran the school alone from her selection until September, 1977, when the defendant appeared on the scene as a "volunteer" teacher, but without the authority or approval of the General Board. At that time, the defendant's participation was not objected to due to her status as daughter of the church's founder and her apparent sincerity.
