WHEREAS, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (hereinafter "DHEC") heretofore issued its Permit to Operate dated April 28, 1983, to Assignor for the operation of an eight-inch sanitary sewer within the above right-of-way to serve Power Drive in Greenville County, a copy of said permit to operate being attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein, and

WHEREAS, Assignor wishes to assign to Assignee all of its right, title and interest in and to the right-of-way and Permit to Operate in order that the Assignee might operate and maintain the eight-inch sewer line.
