

that each of them fully understands all the terms, covenants, conditions, provisions, and obligations incumbent upon each of them by virtue of this instrument and each of them believes the same to be fair, just, reasonable, and to their respective best interest.

7. This instrument may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original whether or not that counterpart is signed by all parties, and said counterparts shall constitute but one and the same instrument which may be sufficiently evidenced by one counterpart.

8. Each of the parties hereto consents to the recording of this instrument in the public records of Greenville County, South Carolina.
