 John Reed was proven before James Harrison Esquire
 by the oath of Isaac Reed; and Ordered to be Recorded
 which was done this 12th day of August 1791
 This Indenture made the Twenty first of December
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
 Eighty nine and in the thirteenth year of our Indepen-
 -dency between James Frasier of Edgefield County and
 John Reed of the County of Greenville and both of the
 state of S. Carolina and ninety six District Mississippi
 that the said James Frasier in & for the consideration
 of the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand
 paid by the said John Reed the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged that bargained and sold aliened & released
 released and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant
 bargain sell alien & release and confirm unto
 unto the said John Reed in his actual possession now
 being by virtue of a bargain and sale to him thereof
 made for one whole year by Indentures of a lease bearing
 date the day ~~before~~ before the date of these presents
 by force of the statute for Transferring of uses into prop-
 -erty and to his heirs & ors Adm^{ors} and assigns one
 certain Tract of Land containing Two hundred & fifteen
 acres, being part of a three hundred and thirty six
 Tract of Land Granted unto Joseph Reed by the Hon^{ble}
 William Moultrie Gov^r the fifth day of June 1786. Rec-
 -orded in the Secretarys Office Book L L L Page 371
 beginning at a stake on the lower corner Tuning & V.
 20th 42 chain crossing Parrijs waggon Road to a corner
 Stake then Tuning 370th 41 Chains 20 links on the
