Hooper to James Hoody was proven before George Sat-
-mon Esq^r by the Oath of Jonathan Hoode and George
- this 29th day of September 1791.

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of
- April one thousand seven hundred and ninety one
between Obadiah Hooper of Greenville County and
- State of S. Carolina of the one part & James Hoody of
the County & State afores^d of the other part Witness-
- eth that for & in consideration of the sum of five
pounds Sterling to him in hand paid the Receipt
- whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Obadiah
Hooper hath Granted bargained sold & conveyed
- & by these presents do hereby Grant bargain sell
and convey to the said James Hoody his heirs and
- assigns a Tract or parcel of land containing one
hundred acres more or less being part of a Tract of
- Four hundred & Twenty Two acres Originally Granted
to said Obadiah Hooper by his Excellency William
- Moultrie the first day of August one thousand
seven hundred & Eighty five Tenth year of Independ-
- dance of America in Greenville County & State
afores^d lying on branches of Armstrong's Creek
- south side S^d Creek bounding on land Originally
Granted to Mary White on Kellys Branch begining
- on said land Tuning to a post Oak thence to a Red Oak
then Included by a Conditional line to S^d White's line
- and with that to the begining S^d James Hoody now
being in Actual possession of S^d premises To have
- and to hold the aforesaid land with all the appur-
tenances thereunto belonging by him the S^d James
