

97 The following Deed of Conveyance from Nicholas Darnall to Tolton Woody being proven before James Blavingame Esq<sup>r</sup> was produced in Open Court February Term 1792 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done 25<sup>th</sup> 1792

This Indenture made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety one & in the sixteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America Between Nicholas Darnall of Pendleton County in the state of S. Carolina of the one part & Tolton Woody of Greenville County & state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of Seventy pounds Sterling in hand paid to the said Nicholas Darnall by the s<sup>d</sup> Tolton Woody before the signing & delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid Nicholas Darnall hath hereby Bargained & sold & conveyed unto the before mentioned Tolton Woody a certain Tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situated in Greenville County & state aforesaid on a Branch of Saluda River being part of a Tract of land Granted to the said Nicholas Darnall on the fourth day of July Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & Eighty five by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> containing three hundred & four acres Beginning and Bounding Southwardly on land laid out for Joseph Bridges and Northward on land laid out for Joseph Duncan and Westward on a conditional line made by the above mentioned Nicholas Darnall & Tolton Woody Together with all and singular the woods waters Profits commodities Accidents & Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto Belonging or in any wise Appertaining To have and to hold the s<sup>d</sup>
