tain plantation or Tract of Land containing three hundred
and twenty Acres be the same more or less lying and being
in the County of Greenville on the North side of the South
fork of Saluda River it being that Valuable Tract of land
whereon the said John Bethuwa Grigsby now lives the said
Tract of land was purchased by the said Grigsby from
Samuel Earle of the State and County as aforesaid the courses
and Boundaries of the said Tract of land will appear by
the Deeds of Conveyance from the said Earle to the said Grigs-
by Also an other small Tract of land containing fifty acres
more or less adjoining the other Tract and lying between that
other Tract of land and Henry Masz's land this said Tract
of Fifty acres the said John Bethuwa Grigsby lately pur-
chased from Capt. Joseph Hughes of the County of Union and
State aforesaid Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
the said John Montith Robinson his Heirs Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} or
assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever by his
Right or Authority according to the True Intent & meaning
of this Indenture shall not claim have hold Occupy
possess or Enjoy any part or parts of either of the s^d Tracts
of land in any manner whatsoever so as to obstruct
Interrupt or molest the said John B Grigsby on either
of the said Tracts of land during his life or the joint
lives of the said John B Grigsby and Elisabeth Grigsby
his wife or the life of the longest liver of either of them
