belonging to Abraham Bradley and Axam Catwell and
Southwardly on lands Belonging to Tolton Wood and
Valentine Thacker Together with all and singular the
woods, waters, profits, commodities Accreditments and
Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any
wise appertaining To have and to hold the said Tract
of land containing Two hundred acres more or less hereby
Granted & Sold with their and every of their Appurtenances
unto the said John Stater his heirs &c^{ors} Adm^{rs} & assigns
for ever and the said Nicholas Darnall for himself his
heirs &c^{ors} Adm^{rs} & assigns the said hereby Bargained
Premises with their Appurtenances unto the said John
Stater his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims
of every person or persons whatsoever shall and with warrant
