



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The following deed of conveyance from William Whor-  
ton & Jean Whorton to William Chandler was proven before  
Robert Mape Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Nicholas Derby and  
Recorded this 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1792.

These indenture made the thirteenth day  
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
hundred and ninety one Between William Whorton of the  
State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina and County of Greenville of the one  
part and William Chandler of the County & State aforesaid  
of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Whor-  
ton for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds  
current money of the State afores<sup>d</sup> unto him in hand  
well and Truly paid by the said William Chandler at and  
before the Invealing & delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof he the said William Whorton do hereby acknowledge  
and thereof and of every part & parcel thereof do for ever  
57 Conclude Acquit and discharge the said William Chandler  
his heirs &c<sup>ors</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> by these presents, have Granted
