William Whorton his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Thomas Wadsworth & William Turpin otherwise Wadsworth &
Turpin will warrant and by these presents for ever defend the
aforesaid plantation or Tract of Land containing 300 acres
against any claim from us our Heirs or assigns and all &
every other persons acting for or under us or by any power
or Right derived from us but from the claim of no other
person whatsoever In Witness whereof the S. parties to these
presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day
and year first above written
