


Interest from the Twenty fifth December ensuing
payable in Charleston warehouse Tobacco notes
(or other Merchantable produce at that place)
at cash price on or before the Twenty fifth day
of December, which will be in the year one thou-
sand seven hundred & ninety, without fraud or
further delay, then this Obligation to be Void or else
to remain in full force & Virtue.
